

A Guide To Parental Controls For **Facebook**



Facebook is a popular social media site that you are more likely to use than your child. Nonetheless, it has detailed privacy settings that allow you to control the types of information about your child that will be made public.

What types of content can I restrict?









Navigating the privacy settings is quite easy. When your child is setting up their account, navigate the privacy settings together to decide on what you are both comfortable with.

What do I do?

- 1. On Facebook, click the **?** button at the top right corner of the page.
- 2. Then, click **Privacy Check-up**.

12. If this says Everyone, click it to change it to **Friends of friends**. This way, strangers will not be able to add your child as a friend on Facebook.

You can also change other settings, such as who can search for your child online using their email address or phone number. Change these to **Friends of friends** or, to be safer, **Friends**.

For the option to link search engines outside Facebook to their Profile, select No.
