

Secure your mobile device by locking it with either a Passcode, Face ID or Pattern (only applicable for Android devices) to prevent unauthorized access to your personal information.



Check for updates and **update your app promptly** to protect your devices from known
security vulnerabilities.




Download apps from **official** sources.

Take a Screenshot


Taking a photo, video or screenshot is one of the methods to store information on your mobile device.

The following steps will guide you to store, retrieve and delete photo, video or screenshot on your mobile device.





Press the "Volume down" and "Power" buttons simultaneously to take a screenshot.



Palm swipe from left to right to capture a screenshot.


Retrieve a Photo, Video or Screenshot






Delete a Photo, Video or Screenshot

- Select Gallery
 - Find and tap the "Gallery" icon.
- 2 Select Photo/Video/ Screenshot



Tap on the photo/video/screenshot you wish to delete.

3 Delete Photo/Video/Screenshot





Tap on the "trash bin" icon to delete. To delete multiple files, press and hold to select those you want to delete.

Bookmark a Website


When you come across a website that you wish to revisit while browsing the Internet, you can bookmark it.


The following steps will guide you to bookmark a website, retrieve the bookmark and delete it if you no longer need it.














Save a Document

The following steps will guide you to save, retrieve and delete a document on your mobile device.












Select if you want to save as "PDF file" or "Image file".







