**Do not** disclose your Singpass login details to others as it can lead to unauthorised access to your accounts and personal information.



financial details, passwords or one-time

password (OTP) with anyone.



Check for updates and **update your app promptly** to protect your devices from known security vulnerabilities.



### **About Health Apps in Singapore**

Health apps such as HealthHub, SingHealth Health Buddy and NHG Cares allow Singaporeans to have one-stop access to all their health services and records. You don't need to recall what your past appointment was about and the medications you have been prescribed. The apps keep a record of them and allow you to retrieve the information easily.


## Pre-requisites to learning the app:

- Have an active email account.






### **Common Features Across Different Health Apps**


# HealthHub **SingHealth** Home icon Brings you to the homepage of the app. **Appointment icon** Allows you to view your current appointment or make a new appointment. **Payment icon** Allows you to make online payment for your medication bills. **Medication icon** Allows you to review your prescription to request to refill medications or submit order for new medications.




### Common Steps to Use Health Apps – Set up or Login

Most health apps in Singapore allow you to login using Singapass. If you have your Singapss set up, you can login to the health apps easily.










### Common Steps to Use Health Apps – Book an Appointment


You can book your appointment easily by tapping on the Appointment icon.


After that, follow the on-screen steps to select the clinic/hospital, purpose of appointment, date & time.













### Common Steps to Use Health Apps – Order or Refill Medication

You can order or refill your medications easily by tapping on the Medication refill or Medicine icon. It will show your past prescriptions and you can request to refill medications or submit orders for new medications.







### Common Steps to Use Health Apps – Make Payment

You can make your medical payment by tapping on the Payment icon. It will show you your pending medical bills for you to pay via the app (credit/debit card payment).









